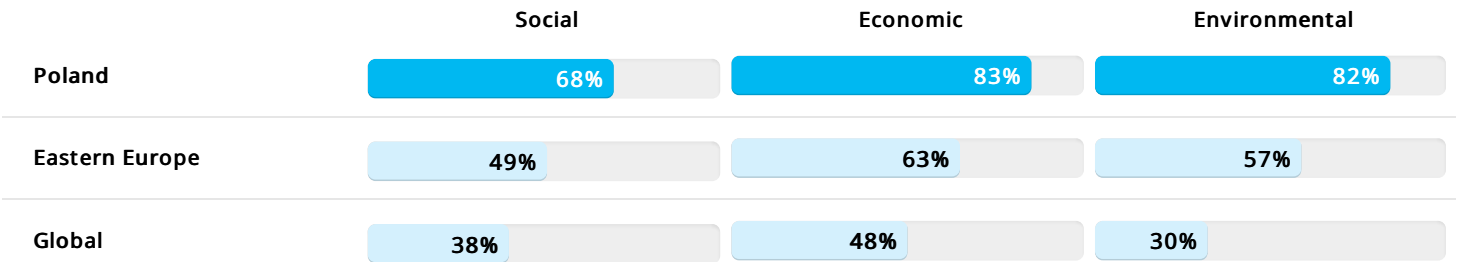

SUMMARY

Poland ranks 4 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 78%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 75% and a data openness subscore of 80%.

Poland scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

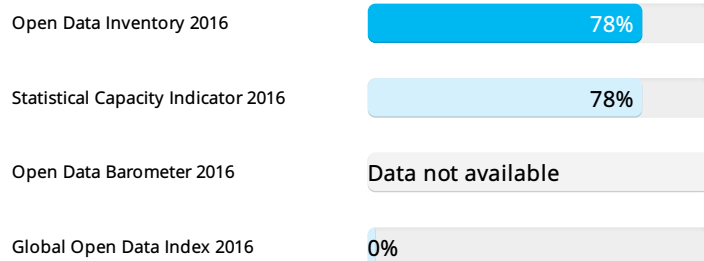
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

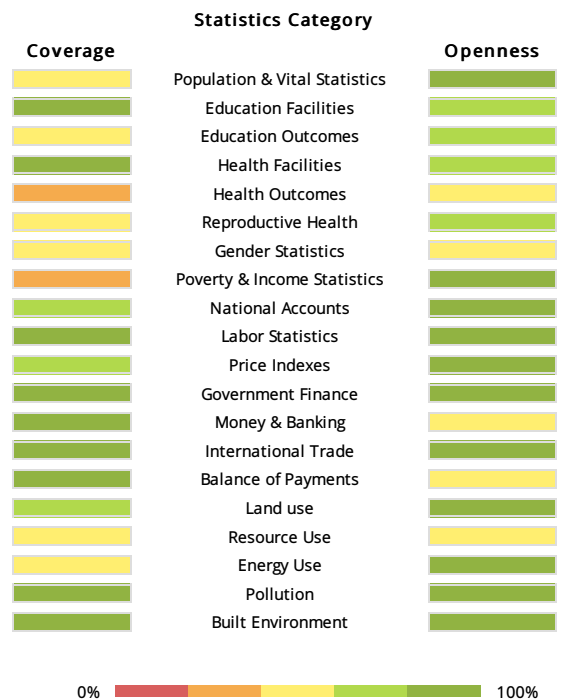
Openness
